Dress Code



This dress code has been established to help our students present themselves modestly. Students are expected to maintain a style of dress, appearance, and hairstyle that is safe, neat, clean, modest and does not draw undue attention from others.

These standards apply while on campus and field trips. Exceptions may be granted by the administration in the case of special, school-sponsored dress days. Students are required to dress according to their biological and chromosomal sex as determined at birth and not subject to change.

<u>Professional Dress Days:</u>

Boys: Dress shirt/pants, tie (optional).
Girls: Dress or skirt/dress pants w/blouse.

**If this is not observed, the student will be asked to wear professional dress the following school day.

Daily Dress Code:

- SPCA/Refuge apparel encouraged every day with the exception of Professional Dress Days.
- **Tops:** Button-down collared shirt, blouse, henley, polo, sweater, or fleece. Shirts tucked when appropriate.
- Pants, slacks, shorts, skirts, or dresses.
- While standing with hands at side, skirts, dresses, shorts, must be length of one's longest finger.
- Leggings may be worn under skirts, tunics, etc.; however they may not be worn alone. The length of the top worn with leggings must be the length of one's longest finger.
- It is recommended that K-6 students wear shorts under skirt/jumper/dress.

Footwear/Accessories:

- Sunglasses, jackets, hats, or other outer coats will be kept in the student's locker (not worn in classroom).
- Sandals, or backless or open-toed shoes may not be worn for outside play. Shoes must be in good condition.
- Students must have tennis shoes and socks at school at all times.

School supplies and backpacks must be free of cartoon characters and logos. Items creating a distraction will be removed.

Neatness, cleanliness, and modesty are to be observed at all times.

Hair & Grooming:

- Hair must be kept a natural color, be styled out of eyes, be kept clean, and be well groomed.
- Tattoos, real or simulated, may not be visible.
- Boys: Facial hair must be clean-shaven or neatly trimmed. No fingernail polish.

Not Allowed:

- Logos, writing, screen printing, or cartoon characters on clothing.
- Sweatpants, workout clothing, athletic pants/shorts, or yoga pants.
- Sleeveless shirts.
- Clothing with visible repairs or holes, or cleavage or mid-section exposed.
- Excessively worn, torn, distressed, soiled, or undersized (tight) clothing.
- Unnatural hair color.

Dress Code Consequences:

- First time: warning & student changes clothes.
- Second time: write up, student changes clothes.
- Third time & following: detention, student changes clothes.

*Homeroom teacher documents dress code consequences in RenWeb and emails parent.

Athletics and Physical Education

No logos, writing, screen printing, or cartoon characters on clothing, with the exception of SPCA apparel. Students in grades K-6 will wear regular school apparel to PE.

Students in grades 7-12 are *required to change* into clothes for PE and should have the following items:

Deodorant, t-shirt, sweatshirt, sweatpants, gym shorts (boys need to wear compression shorts under)

Non-skid athletic shoes & athletic socks (Cleats optional for Flag Football & Soccer)

Volleyball Players: knee pads

Soccer Players: cleats & shin guards

Jewelry: Students are required to remove jewelry when participating in PE or Athletics.

SPCA is not responsible for lost or broken items.
